



ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF DEBT IN TERMS OF SECTION

37D OF THE PENSION FUNDS ACT 24 OF 1956

This document, which is regarded as the Member's written admission of liability to the Employer, is to be completed in the event of a Member leaving service who has caused damage to the Employer by reason of theft, dishonesty, fraud or misconduct. This document authorises the Fund/Administrator to pay over the Member's fund benefit to the Employer in respect of compensation for the damage caused in accordance with the Provisions of Section 37D of the Pension Funds Act 24 of 1956.

A fully completed copy of this form as well as a copy of the employees ID document or passport is to be submitted to the Fund Administrator to enable them to deduct the amount of the debt from the member's benefit payable from the Fund. This amount will then be repaid to the Employer. Proof of banking details of the employer will be required.
